



PJ Library is Going to Camp

The Foundation for Jewish Camp, in partnership with the Harold Grinspoon Foundation's PJ Library Program, is proud to bring you ***PJ Goes to Camp*** – an incentive program for PJ Library first-time campers who live anywhere in North America!

To determine if you are eligible for this grant, please read the paragraph below. If you believe that your camper meets the eligibility criteria, please proceed with the application process by clicking [APPLY NOW!](#) PJ Goes to Camp provides financial incentives of \$1,000 to first-time campers who meet the following criteria:

- The camper is from a PJ Library family (registered members, siblings of and/or alum) and will attend a nonprofit Jewish overnight summer camp for at least 3 weeks (19 consecutive days), or for at least 2 weeks (12 consecutive days) if attending a camp in one of the 13 Western states.
- Eligible campers must be entering grades 2–11 (after camp) and the PJ Library member must have been enrolled in The PJ Library program prior to September 1, 2009 to qualify.
- Eligible campers must attend one of the 150+ camps listed on www.jewishcamp.org.
- If you live in Western Massachusetts, you need not proceed with the online application, please contact Kirstin Gadiel, (413)-439-1968 or at kirstin@hgf.org for more information.

Here's how it works:

There are a number of incentive programs that may be available to your child on onehappycamper.org. The system will automatically direct you to the most appropriate program based on several factors, including where you live and where your child is attending camp. It may be that although you are a PJ Library member, your application may be processed through another program, but regardless of program, all eligible PJ Library applicants will receive a grant.

Before beginning your application:

1. You will need your valid PJ Goes to Camp promotion code
2. Your child must already be signed up for one of the 150+ camps listed at www.jewishcamp.org.
